

The Creation Museum & Ark Encounter

October 24 - 28

THE TRIP YOU HAVE BEEN ASKING FOR:

Marvel as you explore this “state of the art” Creation Museum venture through Biblical history. You will experience stunning exhibits which portray every phase of the Creation story. Stand amazed as you see the Garden of Eden Paradise enjoyed by Adam and Eve, exhibits of dinosaurs which look, act and sound so real, you may want to back away for safety.

Don't get caught outside the Ark, go inside and prepare to be blown away as you explore the life-sized reconstruction of Noah's Ark. Built according to the dimensions given in the Bible, Ark Encounter is a jaw-dropping structure that is hard to believe. State of the art (not ark) technology is employed in the many exhibits you will not want to miss.

On the way back we will overnight in Renfro Valley and enjoy “Tribute to the Legends”, a live music production.

As an added attraction, we **could be** in the middle of the **spectacular change in color** of the leaves.

Important: Bus will **depart** parking lot on Hwy. 1085 side of the building at **7:00 AM** so please arrive about **20 minutes** early so your baggage can be loaded and we can depart on time.

Tuesday, October 24: Depart the Church parking lot at **7:00 AM** and head to Kentucky to visit the “Creation Museum” with an overnight stay in Franklin, Tennessee where we will have a restful evening at the LaQuinta Inn. We will have dinner at the famous “Puckett's Grocery” in downtown Franklin.

Wednesday, October 25: After breakfast at our hotel, we will re-board our motor coach and travel to our destination. We will visit the Creation Museum before checking into our local hotel, The Country Inn. We will go for dinner at an Olive Garden, nearby in Florence, KY.

Thursday, October 26: Have a leisure breakfast at the hotel before we return to the museum at 9 AM for another 3 hours where you will have lunch (OYO) before we depart for a short 45 minute trip to the Ark Encounter in Williams Town, KY. After a short “get acquainted” visit to the Ark, we will check into our Best Western Hotel in George Town. We will have dinner at one of the local restaurants in George Town before getting our richly deserved rest.

Friday, October 27: After breakfast at the hotel, we'll travel back to the Ark to complete our visit there before heading down to Berea, Ky for an early dinner at the historic Daniel Boone Inn. After dinner we will take a short trip on down to “The Renfro” valley where we will check into our local hotel (Days Inn) before enjoying the music that the Renfro Valley is known for. Tonight the show will be a “Tribute to the Legends”.

Saturday, October 28: After an early breakfast we will board our motor coach and head for the barn. It will be a long day, but we will have frequent rest stops including a stop for lunch at a Golden Corral in Cleveland, TN.

RESERVATION and PAYMENT POLICY: Reservations and payments taken only at the monthly Young at Heart meetings. Reservations will be taken on a first come basis at the meeting on **Tuesday, May 16; Tuesday, June 13; Tuesday, July 18; Tuesday, August 15;** and **Tuesday, September 19.** If you cannot attend one of these meetings have someone else sign you up at the YAH trip table with your **check made payable to Young at Heart.** (Note: you cannot make reservations or payments in the church office). Payment made at one of the Young At Heart meetings secures your reservation.

When you make your reservations, indicate who your roommates will be and if you are signing up for someone else make sure you have their information.

MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM: Minimum of 35 people are required to make this trip. The maximum is 40 people.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Cancellations accepted with a full refund **until September 15. After September 15, there will be NO REFUNDS** unless there is a waiting list and someone is willing to take your place. If you have to cancel, contact Angela in the church office to get the name of the next person(s) on the waiting list. **It will be up to you to call that person** and ask that they contact Angela in order to take your place. Once they make their payment, your refund will be mailed to you. You may not transfer your trip to another person on your own if there is a waiting list.

STANDBY: We encourage you to **register** even if you are on the standby list. There are normally those who find it necessary to cancel and therefore, **you will have a high probability of going.** Those listed as standby will need to **make the initial payment only to hold your place on the standby list.** Standby payment **will be refunded** if you do not have the opportunity to make the trip.
