## **Matthew 4:1-11 (NIV)**

- [1] Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.
- [2] After fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry.
- [3] The tempter came to him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."
- [4] Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"
- [5] Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple.
- [6] "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: "'He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."
- [7] Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'"
