RESERVATION AND PAYMENT POLICY: Reservations will be accepted **only at the Young at Heart (YAH) trip table** on a first-come basis from **9:30 – 10:30 AM** at the **November 14**, **January 16**, **March 19**, **and May 21 meetings**. If you cannot attend one of these meetings, have someone else sign you up at the YAH trip table <u>with your CHECK</u> made payable to the First Baptist Church (or FBC). If you are registering for someone else, please be prepared to <u>fill out a registration card</u> with information required: name, DOB, mailing address, home phone, cell phone, email address, room occupancy preference and the names of roommate(s) to match room occupancy preference. No reservations or payments accepted in the church office.

WAITING LIST POLICY: You are encouraged to register even if you are on standby, and the list is long. There are normally those who find it necessary to cancel and therefore, you will have a high probability of going. Those listed as standby will need to make **the initial payment only to hold a place on the waiting list**. Standby payment will be refunded in full if the opportunity to make the trip does not present itself.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations accepted through **April 30** with full refund. Beginning on May 1,2024 a refund will be made only if there is a waiting list, and someone is willing to take your place. If it becomes necessary for you to cancel, call Angela at the church office. You will be given the name of the next person on the waiting list. It will be up to you to contact that person and ask if they are able to take your place. When the person's payment is received, a refund check will be mailed to you.

MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM: The minimum number required for the trip is 35 and the maximum number is 42.
