- 5. Choose which type (Family) and date range (January 1, 2023 December 31, 2023)
- 6. Under Tax Deductible, select "Both Deductible & Non-Deductible".
- 7. Select "Show pledges on giving statement" if you would like your **ANCHORED** pledge included on your statement.
- 8. Click "Run Report".

Now, your statement is ready to view or print.
