8.	Ahab later died in battle (853 BC). His chariot was taken to Jezreel and washed where Naboth had been stoned, and the dogs licked Ahab's blood (1 Kings 22: 34-37).	
9.	Jezebel met her death years later when her son, <i>Joram</i> , was <i>overthrown and killed</i> by his military commander named <i>The LORD had previously anointed Jehu to be king of Israel</i> . His primary responsibility was to (2 Kings 9:1-28).	
10.	When Jezebel learned that Jehu had killed her son, she could see the handwriting on the wall - she would be next. Jezebel's death was tragic just as prophesied. She was throw out of a window , her body was trampled by horses , and her flesh (2 Kings 9:30-37).
