# Who IS That Woman?

Women in the Bible who got it right and those who didn't

## Wicked

## 1 Kings 21

1. Sometime later there was an incident between a **vineyard owner** named \_\_\_\_\_ and King \_\_\_\_\_. The king coveted Naboth's \_\_\_\_\_, which was in Jezreel. Ahab made Naboth **an offer he could not refuse**, or so Ahab thought. However, Naboth \_\_\_\_\_ both offers based on his \_\_\_\_\_ to the **Old Testament inheritance laws** (1 Kings 21:1-3).
2. King Ahab went home \_\_\_\_\_ and **would not eat**. Seeing Ahab **pouting**, Jezebel asked what was wrong. When Ahab told her, she \_\_\_\_\_ him for his behavior and assured him \_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 4-7).
3. Jezebel lost no time hatching a plot to \_\_\_\_\_. She \_\_\_\_\_ King Ahab's name on an official document proclaiming a day of \_\_\_\_\_ for everyone in Jezreel. Next, she commanded the leaders of the town to \_\_\_\_\_ by enlisting **two scoundrels** to **falsely accuse** him of \_\_\_\_\_. They executed the plan flawlessly, \_\_\_\_\_ to death (vv. 8-14).
4. When they notified Jezebel that the mission had been accomplished, she urged Naboth **to get up and take possession of** \_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 15-16).
5. As Ahab gloated over his new possession, \_\_\_\_\_ the prophet arrived with a **message from the LORD**, stating that the King would \_\_\_\_\_, and the **dogs** would \_\_\_\_\_ just as they had Naboth's. Furthermore, **disaster** would come upon **Ahab's household**, and **all** would be \_\_\_\_\_, **including Jezebel** (vv. 17-24).
6. Vv. 25-26 is a sad commentary on a king who was \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and exhibited \_\_\_\_\_ for twenty-two years, letting Jezebel make \_\_\_\_\_ for the nation.

7. Upon hearing this prophetic word, Ahab \_\_\_\_\_, and the LORD \_\_\_\_\_

8. **Ahab** later died in battle (853 BC). His chariot was taken to Jezreel and washed where Naboth had been stoned, and the dogs licked Ahab's blood (1 Kings 22: 34-37).
9. Jezebel met her death years later when her son, **Joram**, was **overthrown and killed** by his military commander named \_\_\_\_\_. **The LORD had previously anointed Jehu to be king of Israel.** His primary responsibility was to \_\_\_\_\_.  
(2 Kings 9:1-28).
10. When Jezebel learned that Jehu had killed her son, she could see the handwriting on the wall - she would be next. Jezebel's death was tragic just as prophesied. She was **thrown out of a window**, her body was **trampled by horses**, and **her flesh** \_\_\_\_\_.  
(2 Kings 9:30-37).
