1 Peter 1:13-21 NIV

- [13] Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming.
- [14] As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance.
- [15] But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do;
- [16] for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."
- [17] Since you call on a Father who judges each person's work impartially, live out your time as foreigners here in reverent fear.
- [18] For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors,
- [19] but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.
- [20] He was chosen before the creation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for your sake.
- [21] Through him you believe in God, who raised him from the dead and glorified him, and so your faith and hope are in God.

Romans 8:29 For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

1 John 3:2 Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.

How Do We Get To That Point?

1. You must be a follower of Christ.

• John 3:7 You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You^[a] must be born again.'

2. You must be a fully devoted follower of Christ.

- Hebrews 12:14 Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.
- <u>Holiness</u> is not an option.
- <u>Sanctification</u> holiness is the goal.

3. You must practice the Disciplines of the Faith.

- The Christian life comes not by <u>indolence</u> but by <u>discipline</u>.
- <u>Partial</u> obedience is <u>disobedience</u>.
- The 10.000-hour rule.
- Your goal will pull you into the future.
- The disciplines place you in the <u>path</u> of God.
